The Brookings City Council held a study session on Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at 5:00 p.m., at City Hall with the following members present: Mayor Tim Reed, Council Members Jael Thorpe, John Kubal, Dan Hansen, Tom Bezdichek, Ope Niemeyer and Keith Corbett. City Attorney Steve Britzman, City Manager Jeff Weldon and City Clerk Shari Thornes were also present.

Discussion topics included a presentation on the Brookings County Youth Mentoring Program, 2015 EdgeBrook Golf Course Review, discussion on future uses of the land near the Brookings Regional Airport, and City Council ex-officio reports.

A motion was made by Council Member Thorpe, seconded by Council Member Niemeyer, to direct the City Manager to draft a resolution encouraging Brookings Municipal Utilities to cooperate with local agencies with regards to reconnect fees. The motion carried by the following vote: Yes: 7-Reed, Bezdichek, Corbett, Hansen, Kubal, Niemeyer, and Thorpe.
