**Resolution to declare Ballistic Vest as surplus property (Police Dept.)**

Whereas, the City of Brookings purchases Ballistic Vests as a capital expenditure, and half the cost is reimbursed from the Federal Government; and


Whereas, Officer Laurie Smith has resigned her position with the Brookings Police department effective January 7, 2018. She will begin working for the Deuel County Sheriff's office and has requested to keep her ballistic vest for use in her new position; and

Whereas, Ballistic vests are made to fit the officer they are intended for and are male/female specific. Officer Smith's vest would most likely not fit anyone else properly and would be best utilized if she were to retain possession.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the governing body of the City of Brookings, SD, that this property be declared surplus property according to SDCL Chapter 6-13.
