The Airport Board is an advisory board to the City Manager and Council on matters concerning the city airport. The board meets monthly and receives reports on the operation of the airport from the Airport Manager, City Engineer, FBO, SDSU and other interested parties. It reviews proposed construction plans, recommends leases of airport land for hangars, and reviews the operations of the airport and makes recommendations for improvements as necessary. The Airport Board reviews concerns and complaints in an effort to resolve issues. There are 5 members on this advisory board.
