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**POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN
BROOKINGS PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES**

The Brookings Parks and Recreation Department understands that there are events and activities that take place in City-owned parks and facilities where participants will find it desirable to include the responsible consumption of malt and wine beverages. In order to help the public better understand the limits which are in place in these parks and facilities, the following policy has been written:

The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in the City of Brookings Parks System is limited to malt beverages and wine products, including wine coolers and similar beverages. At no time are beverages that include hard liquor allowed in City parks and facilities (Sexauer Park exception: camping patrons of legal age may responsibly consume hard liquor within their reserved campsite.) Activities which include the presence of alcoholic beverages and more than 20 people need written approval from the Parks, Recreation & Forestry Director. Only non-glass containers are allowed in City parks and facilities.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be present during organized youth activities (under 18 years old), including but not limited to: baseball, basketball, football, hockey, ice rinks, skateboard, soccer, softball, tennis, and other recreational programming. No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be present in City parks which are customarily used as school playgrounds during the school year, typically mid-August to late-May.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed to prohibit the possession of malt and/or wine beverages on City parks premises which are permitted to a concessionaire and said concessionaire has an appropriate malt and/or wine beverage license(s).
